

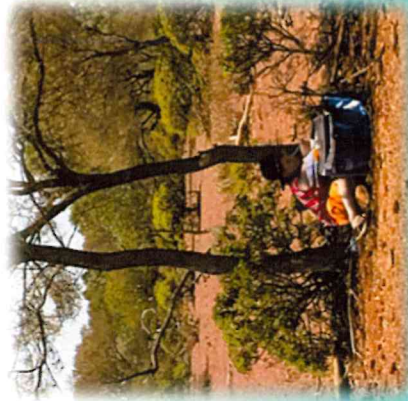
“Thank you ICPA”

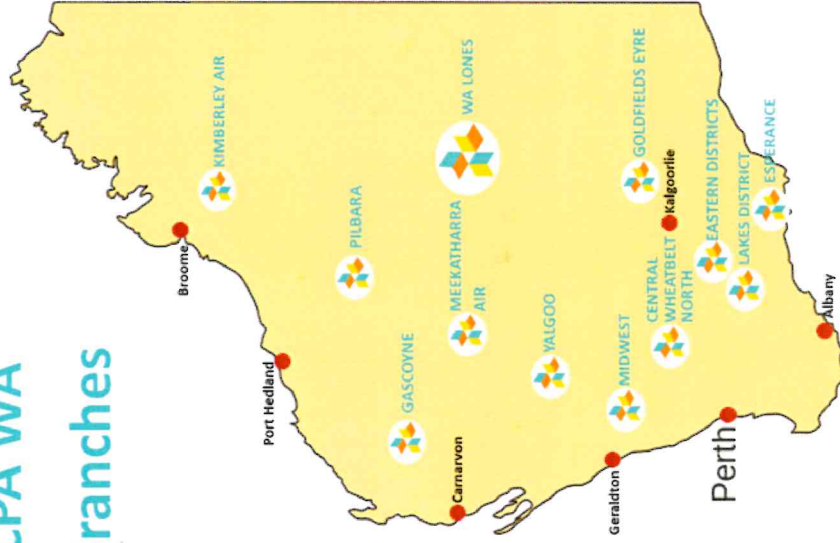
They receive a Distance Education allowance to help with costs in the schoolroom.
