- Students who can demonstrate enthusiasm for agriculture as the main reason why they want to attend Morawa College of Agriculture
- Student must be planning to be boarders at the residential campus

The scholarship funds will be held by the college and the successful recipient can use the funds for expenses such as uniforms, excursions, camps, boarding fees and course fees.
