# CERTIFICATE II IN AGRICULTURE

This qualification describes the skills and knowledge for general job roles in rural and regional Australia, and supporting job roles in agriculture including livestock production, cropping or in the case of mixed farming workplaces, both cropping and livestock. Job roles vary across different industry sectors. Individuals with this qualification carry out routine tasks under supervision where the work is predictable and structured with limited judgement requirements.



## **Agriculture Pathways**

Agricultural College graduates are well sought after in the farming industry. The hours spent working and learning on the college farm throughout their three years provide them with an advantage over other school leavers in many entry level roles in agriculture. These include

- Livestock management and stock and station traineeships
- Grain and horticultural production
- Machinery operation and management
- Wool industry roles from the paddock through to auction room floor
- Agricultural apprenticeships and traineeships
